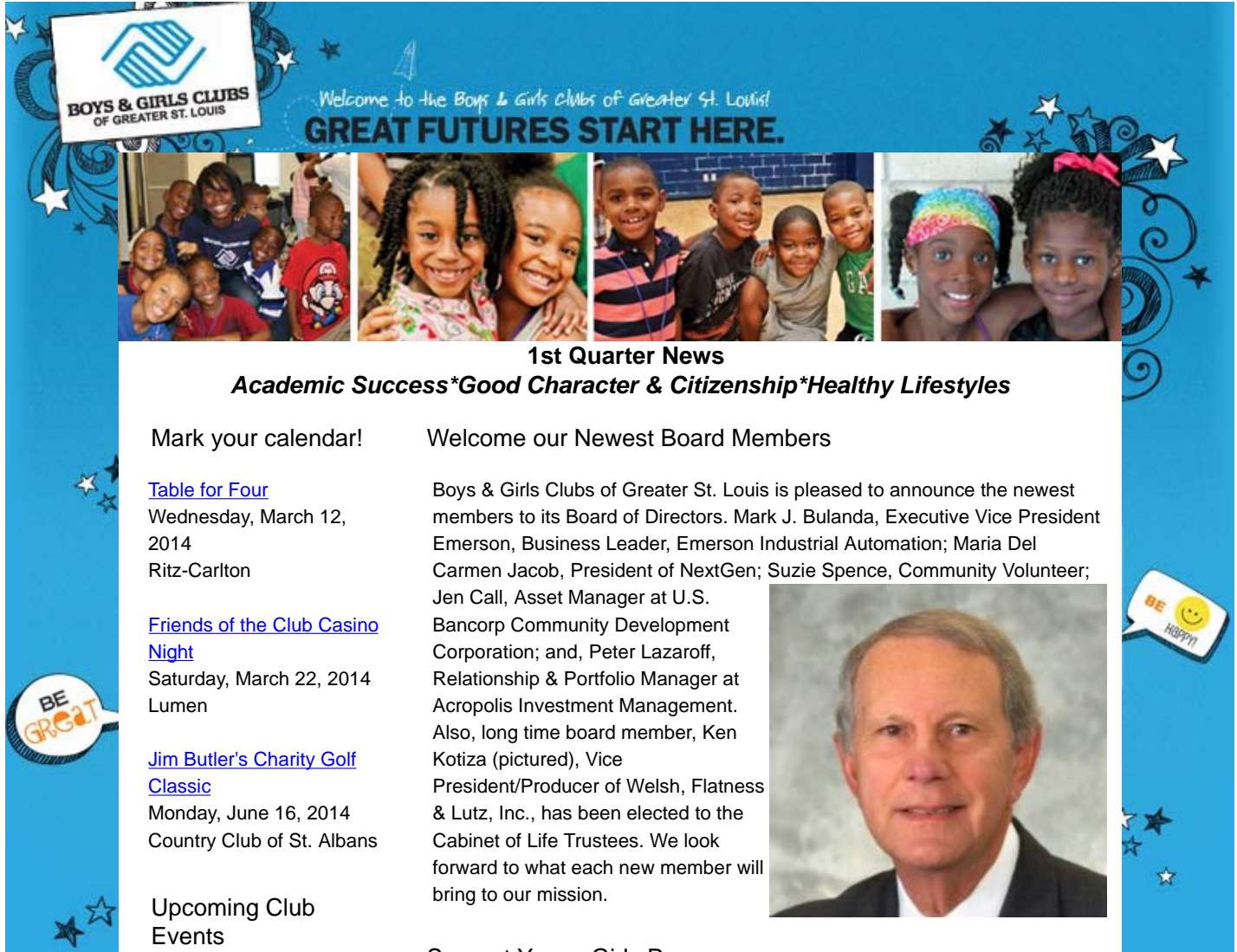

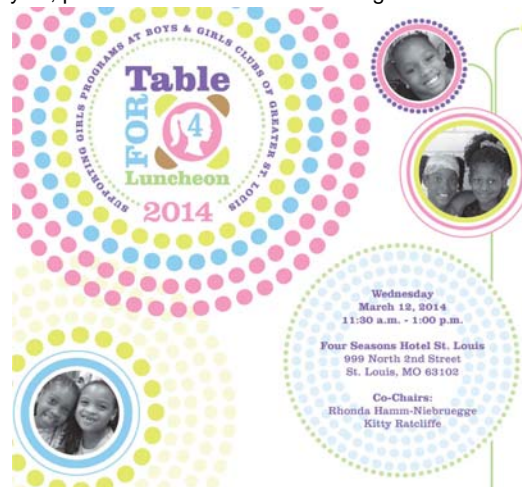
Welcome our Newest Board Members

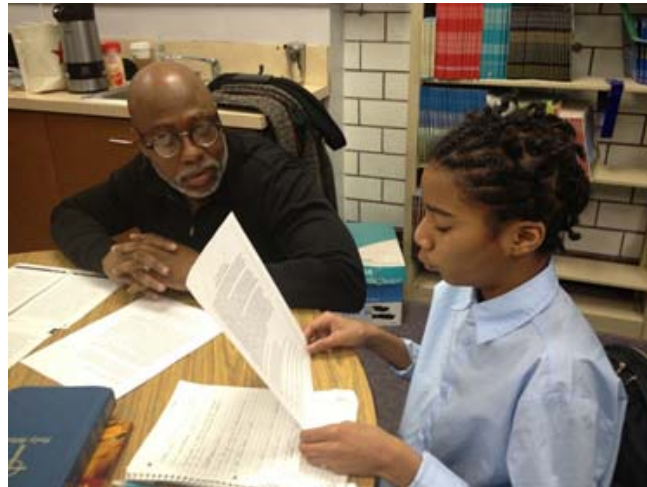

## Mentor Moment

In 2002, Kenneth Turner wanted to get involved with activities that allowed him to give back to his community. He joined Mentor St. Louis because he saw an opportunity to better the community by building a positive relationship with a child in a controlled setting, alongside other volunteers desiring to do the same. Twelve years and a handful of mentees later, Ken maintains that his experience keeps getting better year after year. As a seasoned mentor, Kenneth has seen multiple iterations of the program. "Good organizations, like Mentor St. Louis, stay on top by constantly finding ways to improve," adds Kenneth. Lately, his focus has been on recruiting additional volunteers through his employer – Thompson Coburn.



Ken believes that if more people gave mentoring a try, they might be surprised at how much they would receive. Ken reports that his current mentee for the past 4 years, Traydon (pictured), has developed into a young man that inspires him, as the mentor. Ken is encouraged because he knows his work with Traydon has helped him transform from a child who received multiple referrals to the principal's office – to now a class leader who is frequently asked to give encouraging messages to the entire student body. When asked what keeps him motivated, Ken said, "Our children need and deserve mentors. Being one of the key people in a child's life that can impact change is the motivation that keeps my motor running". ## Community Grants Continue to Increase the Impact of Club Programs

The BGCSTL is the recipient of multiple gifts that will support our efforts to inspire and enable youth to realize their full potential as productive, responsible and caring citizens. The financial support will drive our results in our three priority outcome areas: Academic Success, Good Character & Citizenship, and Healthy Lifestyles. The following investors recently made contributions:

Support from the **Monsanto Fund** in the amount of \$25,000 will help over 500 kids improve their math and science skills through afterschool tutoring and enrichment activities. The program will take place at five Club locations in St. Louis City and County. Grant funds will be spent on STEM related programming throughout 2014. Activities vary by Club location, and include guest speakers, math- and science-related games, field trips, and LEGO robotics teams.

The **Bellwether Foundation** donated \$15,000 to support Project Learn programs and activities including homework help and tutoring.
