<p>IMAGERY - WORDS OR PHRASES THAT CREATE MENTAL IMAGES OR APPEAL TO THE SENSES</p>	<p>RHyme SCHEME - PLACING RHYMING WORDS AT THE END OF LINES OF POETRY</p>

<p>THE PRESENCE OF A BLACK PRESIDENT DOES NOT SET PRECEDENCE PEOPLE PROPOSE THAT THIS IS WHERE THE PROOF IS</p>	<p>BETHANY'S WORDS FLIPPED, TWISTED, BOUNCED AND LANDED SOFTLY IN HER POEM SHOWING HOW SHE WAS AN ACROBAT WITH LANGUAGE.</p>
